

### Creating a JASTA Contest Log

MMJASTA is a program that generates the log and summary sheets for the JASTA SSTV contest, which regularly is held in August. It reads the log data of MMSSTV, calculates the score and generates the log and summary sheets for JA and non-JA stations.

MMJASTA automatically picks out the contest QSOs by referring to the date and HisRSV fields in your MMSSTV log. Therefore, the MMSSTV log file can contain non-contest QSOs. In order to make this work properly, be sure to record a six-digit RSV + contest sequence number for each valid contest QSO.

### Download MMJASTA

Simply visit the MMSSTV section in the MM Hamsoft web site at [www.hamsoft.ca](http://www.hamsoft.ca) Scroll to the bottom of the page and download. Then launch the .exe program and follow the installation directions. A text document accompanies the download. Refer to it for specific instructions.

You will automatically be asked to complete the setup form.

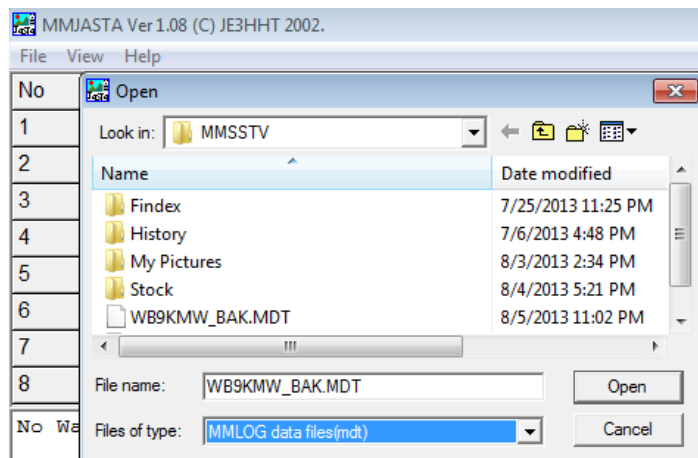

When you are ready to load all your JASTA contest contacts from the MMSSTV log, just go to the File>Load Log in MMJASTA and look for and select your MMSSTV .MDT log.



That will import all your JASTA contacts into MMJASTA and ignore the non-contest QSOs.
